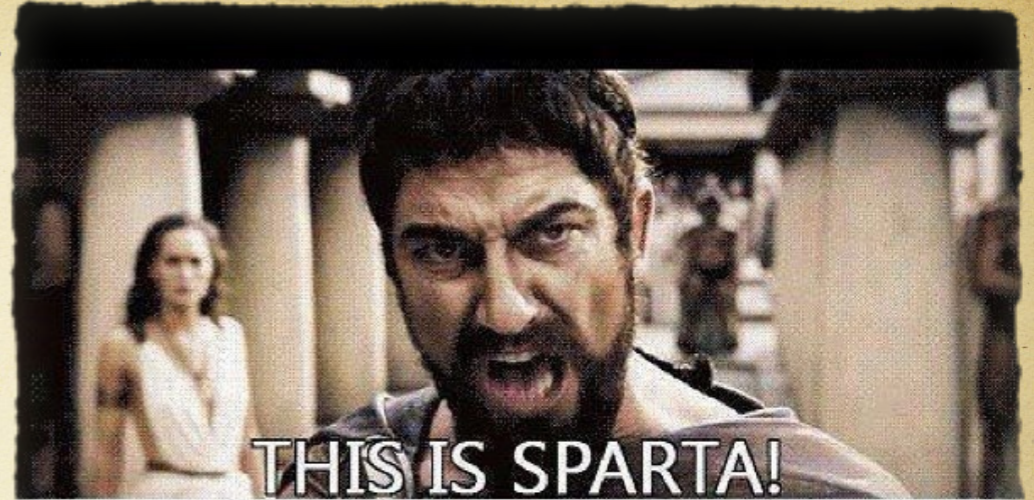

How was it founded?

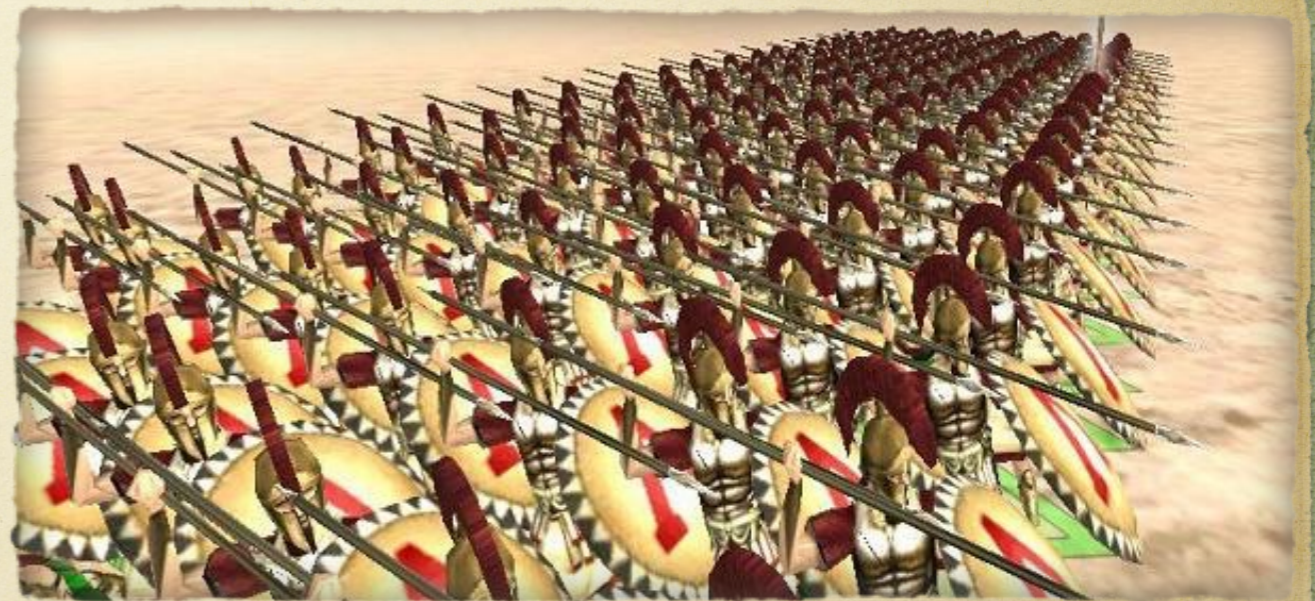
➤ In Greek mythology, Sparta was founded by Lacedaemon, son of Zeus, who gave his and his wife's name to the city.

A spartan probably doesn't look like him



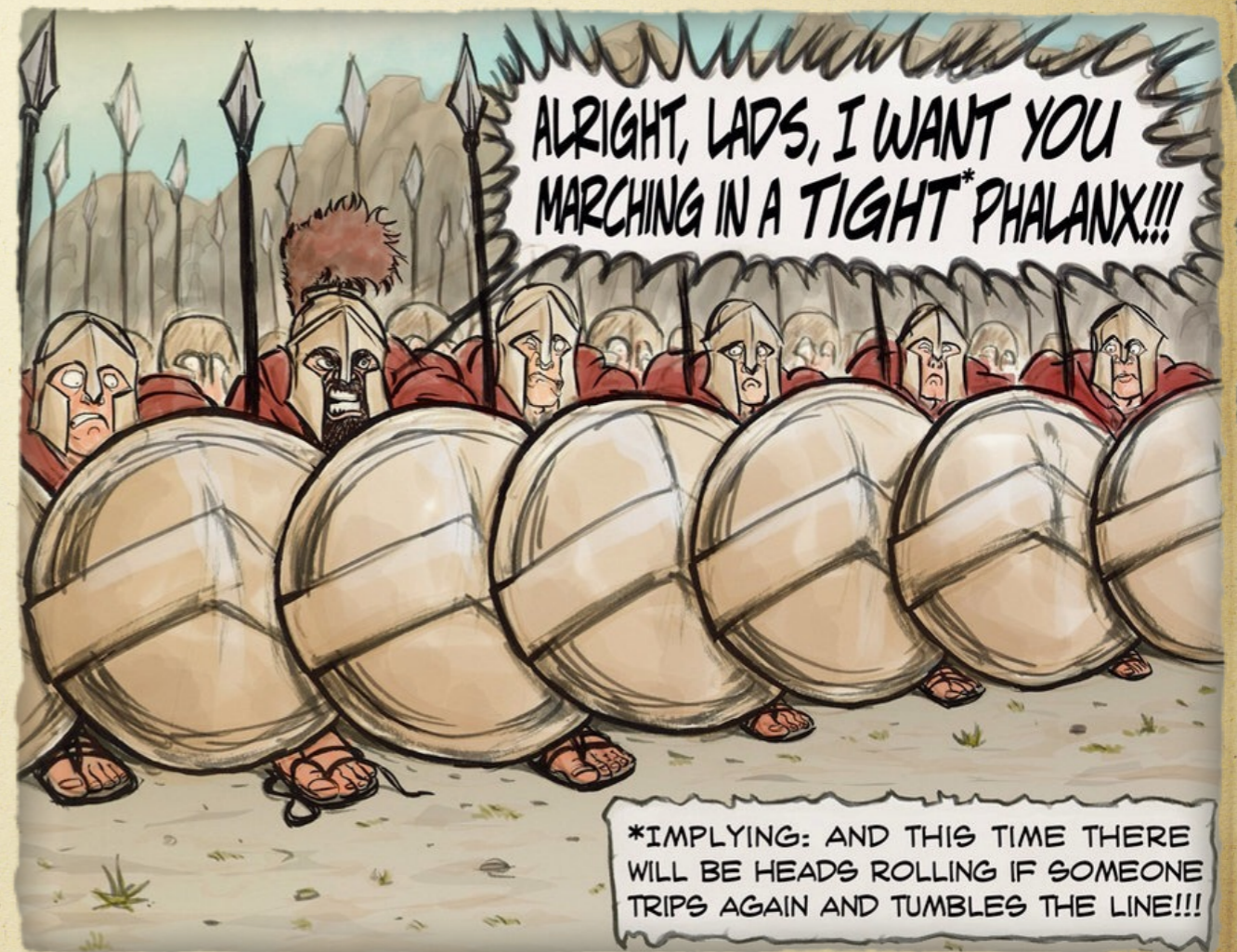
